

# BOBBY BONNER CODE OF CONDUCT FORM

Parents/Guardians:

Please read the following conduct form, complete, sign and return to your manager.

**All Players, Parents, Coaches, and spectators must abide by the following Conduct Rules.**

1. **Conduct** - Any abuse, either verbal or physical, of any umpire, player, manager, or coach will not be tolerated. Violators risk not only forfeiture of the game involved, but also expulsion from the league. Swearing will not be tolerated and will result in the ejection from the game. The Umpire has the authority to eject any player, manager, coach, or parent for any violation of these conduct rules. Umpire's decision on ejection can not be protested. Parent/spectators are expected to be in control of their emotions and behaviors.

2. **Suspension** - A manager can be suspended from managing or coaching due to any unreasonable actions by themselves, coaches, or parents. Any manager has the right to discipline players during a game for conduct rule infractions.

3. **Equipment** - Players should be reminded that the throwing of a batting helmet, bat, glove or any other object in a fit of temper is grounds for immediate ejection from the game. Any player guilty of breaking or damaging league equipment through an act of deliberate abuse will be required to reimburse the league for the replacement value of that equipment and will be suspended; and will remain suspended at least until such reimbursement is made.

4. **Safety** - Batting helmets with face masks are available for all players at all levels. This equipment is optional, however GCB recommends the usage of this equipment. Usage will be left up to the player and/or his/her parent(s)/guardian(s). At a minimum, all players at all levels must wear a batting helmet with or without a face mask for the following situations: Use of a batting helmet by the batter, on deck batters, and all base runners is mandatory. Any player coaching a base must wear a batting helmet.

5. **Uniforms** - Long pants, rubber or molded cleats/sneakers and the supplied sponsor shirt and hat are required to participate in a game. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times. Managers, Umpires, and Directors will monitor and enforce this rule.

6. **Field Litter** – At the end of each scheduled game all litter must be removed from the field and dugout areas.
